Prepare Yourself to Vote in the 2006 General Election

Port St. Lucie, FL – With Election Day right around the corner, now is the time to make sure you are a registered voter within the county you live. The General election will take place on November 7, 2006. If you have not received your registration identification card, are in need of another registration card, or would like to request an absentee ballot, please contact your local supervisor of elections listed below.

If you move to another county in Florida, you must be registered in your new county by October 9, 2006 to be eligible to vote. If your application is complete and you qualify as a voter, the supervisor of elections will mail you a registration identification card as official notification of your registration. If you have any questions, you should contact your county supervisor of elections.

Early Voting

Starting October 23rd, all supervisors will begin conducting early voting in their main and branch offices. Voters who want to vote early should remember to bring a photo and signature identification with them. If you are a first-time voter who registered by mail and requested an absentee ballot, you will be required to send a copy of your picture identification with your absentee ballot, unless you have already provided the identification to the supervisor of elections. If you do not have picture identification, you may send one of the following with your absentee ballot, if they contain your name and current residence address: utility bill; bank statement; government check; paycheck; other government document (excluding voter identification card).

Absentee Voting

You should request an absentee ballot from the supervisor of elections in your county. You may telephone your request or send the request in writing. Provide the following information in your request: your name; your address; and your date of birth. If you send the request in writing, you must sign the request.

Important Dates

- October 23, 2006 - November 4, 2006: Early Voting Days
- November 7, 2006 : General Election Day
